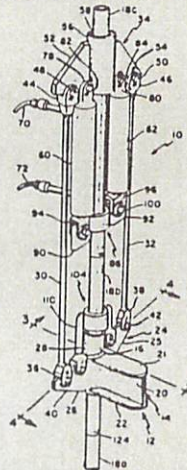

1. Apparatus for stabilizing and supporting a building foundation comprising:

a foundation bracket assembly comprising an elongated foundation support segment adapted to extend generally horizontally under a building foundation, and vertically oriented, guide means substantially at the level of said foundation support segment adapted to receive and guide foundation support pilings to be driven into the ground.
